

## Science College 2013, June 12 “Responsibility in Research”

You are cordially invited to take part in this year’s Science College focussing on the topic "Responsibility in Research".

**Date: June 12, 2013 (all day)**

**Venue: Veranstaltungszentrum Mensa (level 04)**

This year’s Science College highlights the challenges in mastering responsibilities in scientific research, especially in doctoral research. In lectures and discussions focus will be given to aspects such as

- What does good scientific practice mean and what are the challenges for the conduct of good scientific practice in context of doctoral research?
- What are reasonable measures promoting good scientific practice and research integrity? What are the challenges and difficulties in the conduct of research integrity for early stage researchers?
- How does the concept of self-regulation and shared responsibility work concerning misconduct and fraud within the scientific community?
- Is there a learning effect from cases of misconduct within the scientific community?
- What can we learn from experiences in other countries?
- What are special challenges for doctoral researchers?

Science College 2013 will start with 4 keynote lectures giving different thematic emphasis of the overall topic. The lectures will be followed by 5 parallel table discussions in the afternoon, hosted by doctoral colleagues. In the discussions you are invited to discuss the issues raised before among your doctoral community and add your topics of interest. Your Comments, conclusions, recommendation or questions will be summed up later in a plenary discussion with participation of all invited lecturers.

The day will end with a common dinner, where you have the chance to continue discussions with all participants in an informal atmosphere.
